**WHEREAS**, the purpose of this holiday is to encourage all Americans to fulfill Martin Luther King's vision of freedom, equality and opportunity for all people; and

**WHEREAS**, the Dunbar Heritage Association will commemorate the life and contributions of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. on Monday, January 17, 2011, with a special ceremony at the Hays County Courthouse, followed by a walk down Lyndon B. Johnson Drive to Martin Luther King Drive to the Dunbar Community Center for a birthday reception; and

**WHEREAS**, this special event celebrates the historic connection between President Johnson and Martin Luther King, Jr. as they transformed American civil rights in the 1960's.
