DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT FOR ADDITIONAL OFFICE SPACE IN PRECINCT FOUR

Commissioner Whisenant, Hays County Sheriff Cutler and Captain Mike Davenport, Commissioner Conley, Commissioner Ingalsbe and Director of Development and Community Services, Clint Garza spoke. The existing Office Building in Precinct Four is in need of more office space in order to provide basic county services to the residents of the Dripping Springs, Wimberley and Driftwood areas. In Lieu of expanding the existing building, a proposal has been made to lease office space for the Sheriff's Office which in turn will provide space of additional county services needed in the Precinct 4 Building. This will provide a 3-5 year interim ability to plan a long range solution. A motion was made by Commissioner Whisenant, seconded by Judge Cobb to have the Sheriff's Department with the Judge's Office to look into entering a Lease Agreement for 2,400 square feet area to be provided, for Dripping Springs Office Space needs in Precinct 4. Commissioner Ingalsbe, Commissioner Jones and Commissioner Conley voting "No". Commissioner Whisenant and Judge Cobb voting "Aye". MOTION FAILED.
