The Student Election Clerk program is designed to provide student with a greater awareness of the electoral process and the rights and responsibilities of voters.

Student Election Clerks must be at least 16 years old but not yet 18 years old.

If you will be 18 by Election Day, you must be a registered voter of Hays County to work as an Election Clerk. Texas law allows you to register as early as 17 years and 10 months.
