NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON HAYS COUNTY FY 2019 BUDGET

Notice is hereby given that the County of Hays will hold a public hearing on the proposed FY 2019 budget on September 18, 2018 at 1:00 p.m., in the Commissioners' Courtroom, Hays County Courthouse, 111 E. San Antonio St., San Marcos, TX 78666.

This budget will raise more revenue from property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of \$1,458,446 or 1.96% increase from last year's budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$3,789,867.

Prior to the adoption and thereafter, a copy of the budget will be on file in the offices of the Hays County Clerk and Hays County Auditor, as well as the County's website @ www.co.hays.tx.us for public inspection.
