Project Details

Hays County and the Texas Department of Transportation in partnership with the Federal Highway Administration are considering modifications to the I-35 and Posey Road intersection. Changes may include removing the existing Posey Road Bridge and reconstructing I-35 over Posey Road along with six ramp reversals, and conversion of two-way frontage roads. The purpose of this proposed project is to enhance safety and mobility.

Open House

The purpose of the open house is to share project information with the public and obtain public input to be considered during the development of the project. The meeting will be an open house format and there will be no formal presentation. Attendees will be able to view project maps, environmental constraints maps, visit one-on-one with project team members, ask questions, and share comments on the project.
