
Hays County is constructing a path for pedestrians and cyclists on Sawyer Ranch Road from Meadow Creek Drive to Belterra Drive. The path is essentially a wide sidewalk to accommodate those walking and biking. The purpose of this project is to enhance safety and improve connectivity for the community, between neighborhoods, and to Sycamore Springs Elementary and Middle Schools.



## **Details**

- Construct a 4-foot shoulder, raised slotted curb, and a 10-foot shared-use path along the east side of Sawyer Ranch Road
- Add striped crosswalks at Tom Sawyer Road, White Wash Way, Rachels Canyon Drive, and Meadow Creek Drive intersections
- Path will be constructed within existing right-of-way with minimal impacts to traffic
- There are no changes to the speed limit and no additional stop signs or signals
- Funded from voter-approved 2016 Hays County Bond Program
