NOTICE OF AN EMERGENCY ADDENDUM TO THE PREVIOUSLY POSTED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE
COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF HAYS COUNTY, TEXAS



This Notice is posted pursuant to the Texas Open Meetings Act. (VERNON'S TEXAS CODES ANN. GOV. CODE CH.551). The Hays County Commissioners' Court at its regular meeting of June 4, 2002 recessed until **1:00 P.M.**

This emergency addendum is being posted pursuant to Section 551.045, Texas Government Code to enable the Commissioners Court to authorize an emergency expenditure of funds relating to the evacuation of the Hays County Justice Center. An emergency relating to public health and safety exists due to recently received air quality testing results at the Hays County Justice Center and the need to remediate items being removed from the Justice Center and negotiate a contract for the lease of temporary buildings.

ACTION ITEMS

1. Discussion with possible action to declare an emergency pursuant to Section 111.010, Texas Local Government Code, to amend the Hays County Budget due to a grave public necessity to authorize funding relating to the evacuation, testing and remediation at the Hays County Justice Center.

The Commissioners' Court will announce it will go into Executive Session, if necessary, pursuant to Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code, to receive advice from Legal Counsel to discuss matters of land acquisition, litigation, and personnel matters as specifically listed on this agenda. The Commissioners' Court may also announce it will go into Executive Session, if necessary, to receive advice from Legal Counsel regarding any other item on this agenda.
