Dear Colleagues,

Last year's unprecedented and historic storm season once again showed that Texas is a national leader in hurricane response. Your dedication and your countless hours of service to your fellow citizens allowed us to meet the challenge of three hurricanes, a tropical storm and three other major flood events within a 58 day period.

Our jobs will never be easy. But a key to making our work less difficult is to ensure that our citizens are aware, educated and prepared to deal with hurricanes and all other hazards.

Hurricane Preparedness Week in Texas has been set for May 24 - 30, 2009. This is an opportunity to remind Texans along the coast that storm season predictions are only predictions and "all it takes is one" to do devastating damage to a community.

It is also an opportunity to remind Texans in other areas of the state to monitor broadcast media for information about hurricanes because these deadly storms can cause flooding and tornadoes hundreds of miles away. In addition, evacuations have an impact on highway traffic and communities far from the coast as evacuees seek shelter.

The National Weather Service, the Governor's Division of Emergency Management, local officials and emergency managers will be reminding our coastal residents to double check their emergency supply kits and go over their emergency plans – and to talk to neighbors who may be new to the Texas coast – about the need for hurricane preparedness.






