SUMMARY: To refresh the Court: the Parks Advisory Team last year recommended, and the Commissioners Court agreed, to general terms for conservation of the Dahlstrom Ranch, an historic ranch between Buda and Dripping Springs with highly significant water recharge features. Partners include the Hill Country Conservancy, the City of Austin, the National Park Service RTCA program, and, most of all, the Dahlstrom family. Since then, the county has entered depth negotiations with the goal of a contract to govern land use and public access on what would be a landmark public-private conservation easement plan in the state of Texas. One of the most innovative -and challenging - aspects of the project is the proposed public access to the "Howe Pasture" - an area about the size of Austin's Zilker Park, conceived to be for public access and education. A broad-based committee consisting of staff and stakeholders is meeting as the "Public Access Steering Committee" to work out details, while attorneys continue to work toward a final closing within the next few months. The committee includes current and former members of the county parks board, staff members, and representatives from the Barton Springs Edwards Aquifer Conservation District, the Dahlstrom family, the Hill Country Conservency, and the parks departments of Buda and Kyle, and the City of Austin. Kathryn Nichols, a Hays County resident, long-time park advocate and an employee of the National Park Service, facilitates the meetings. Ms. Nichols will be in Court, possibly with other members of the committee, to update the Commissioners Court and public on the committee's progress and details of the proposed plan. The committee has been working closely with Commissioner Barton and his office.
