

AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY JUDGE TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FEMA ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE HAYS COUNTY FIRE MARSHAL'S OFFICE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$12,346.00

The grant application is for equipment (FLIR thermal imaging camera and Night Vision Monocular) for the Hays County Fire Marshal's Office. The equipment will enhance the ability to conduct investigations during the night and/or under limited lighting conditions. The Fire Marshal is mandated by law to investigate all fires and explosions in unincorporated Hays County. Both the FLIR thermal imaging camera and the Night Vision Monocular will allow the officer to view scenes in total darkness. The FLIR can be used to find crime scene evidence, locate victims trapped in various situations, and can be used during flood events to survey the scene during the night. No matching funds are required. The grant will be submitted electronically and is due April 27, 2012. Hays County has partnered with the Lower Colorado River Authority (LCRA) and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) to complete the study, and the USACE is providing approximately 50% of the total study cost. Halff Associates, Inc. is a subcontractor to the USACE for the study, and has provided hydraulic and hydrologic engineering for the drainage basins, completing these tasks for the Onion Creek, Bear and Little Bear creek watersheds. Phase 1B of the study includes the Barton Creek and Pedernales River watersheds, and the attached proposal involves Hays County contracting directly with Halff Associates to conduct survey of



structures and channel sections in the Barton Creek watershed as a component of the overall study. Findings will be incorporated into the final study report prepared by the USACE. The cost for the survey work is \$65,000, to be shared equally between the TWDB grant and Hays County funds, and will serve as match to the USACE portion of the study costs. The total funds committed by Hays County to this study will not change. Halff Associates was previously contracted by the County to conduct study-related tasks for drainage segments in the Buda and Dripping Springs areas, and is a Hays County pre-approved professional services firm for engineering/survey related services. SUMMARY: Steve Harper is proposing an OSSF to serve a towing business at 141 S. Canyonwood in Precinct 4. This property is 1.702 acres. Water will be supplied by Public Water Supply. This OSSF is a standard treatment system in which the effluent will be pumped to a low pressure dosed drainfield. The system is designed for a maximum of 60 gpd. The system designer, Derrick Lormand, R.S. is requesting a variance to Section 10-M(B) of the Hays County rules for on-site sewage facilities which requires flow equalization. His justification is that the system is designed to treat 60 gallons per day. This number is quite conservative given that this is an office with only two employees. Chapter 285 suggests only 4 gallons per day per occupant. Even with some wastewater flow added for the occasional visitor, the system is oversized by several hundred percent. In order to achieve a reasonable retention time of 24 hours, the septic tank volumes is assumed at 3Q. Three times the flow rate in this system would be 180 gallons. The proposed septic tank volume included with our design is 1,000 gallons - again oversized by 500%. It is the opinion of staff, that the oversized septic tank volume will act as a baffle and provide the necessary flow equalization required. Adding an equalization tank in front of this septic tank would actually cause more damage than leaving the system as designed.
