RE: Jail capacity

Hays County's current maximum jail capacity is **362** inmates. Jail Standards recommends holding approximately 10% of capacity open. That lowers our recommendation to **311**.

The jail's daily average was 282 and peak was 288 on October  $18^{th}$  for the week of October 13 to October 19, 2013.

The maximum female capacity is **56** inmates.

Last week's average was 45 and peak was 53 on 10/13/2013.

The maximum male capacity is **276** inmates.

Last week's average was 237 and peak was 242 on 10/18/2013.
