The purpose of this Amendment is to include a Special Provision covering response efforts by Local Health Departments.

Therefore, DSHS and Contractor agree as follows:

PROGRAM ATTACHMENT NO.-003-003A

SECTION VIII, SPECIAL PROVISION, is revised to add the following:

General Provisions, ARTICLE II SERVICES, Section 2.02 Disaster Services, is revised to include the following:

In the event of a local, state, or federal emergency the Contractor has the authority to utilize approximately 5% of staff's time supporting this Program Attachment for response efforts. DSHS shall reimburse Contractor up to 5% of this Program Attachment funded by Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for personnel costs responding to an emergency event. Contractor shall maintain records to document the time spent on response efforts for auditing purposes. Allowable activities also include participation of drills and exercises in the prevent time period. Contractor shall notify the Assigned Contract Manager in writing when this provision is implemented.

All other terms and conditions not hereby amended are to remain in full force and effect. In the event of a conflict between the terms of the Contract and the terms of this Amendment, this Amendment shall control.
