**SUMMARY**

On October 23, 2012 the Commissioners Court approved a Subaward Agreement with Texas State University for participation in the Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training (ALERRT) - VALOR program. On April 9, 2013 the Commissioners' Court approved the first amendment for this program, changing the training officer, extending the project completion date, and increasing the project budget.

The current Amendment Number 13005-8-1812-1B-1966 will extend the project completion date to September 30, 2014 and increase funding by \$10,671.00, to a total project amount not to exceed \$24,070.00. Attached is the amendment.
