



A Resolution of the Hays County Commissioners Court  
Supporting Submission of a State Infrastructure Bank Loan to the Texas Department of  
Transportation for the FM 110 Project

**WHEREAS**, development and construction of projects in the Hays County Priority Road Bond Program and Pass-Through Finance Program are moving forward and nearing completion; and

**WHEREAS**, Hays County has identified additionally-needed roadway projects and has coordinated with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Administration about entering into a new Partnership Program to develop and construct these identified projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has identified surplus funds from its Priority Road Bond Program and Pass-Through Finance Program that could be utilized in the proposed Partnership Program;

**WHEREAS**, the County has received direction from the Texas Department of Transportation requesting that the County submit a State Infrastructure Bank (SIB) loan as part of the process to formalize the Hays County-Texas Department of Transportation Partnership program; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has approved directing its consultants to initiate project financing implementation strategies for the proposed Hays County-Texas Department of Transportation Partnership Program;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Hays County Commissioners Court:

- (a) That the Hays County Commissioners Court does hereby support the submission of a SIB loan application in the amount of \$48.0 million for the construction of the County's priority project, FM 110 from IH 35 at Yarrington Road to SH 123.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Hays County Commissioners Court:

- (a) That the Hays County Commissioners Court urges the Texas Department of Transportation to expedite the review and approval of the County's SIB loan application for the FM 110 project.
