WHEREAS, emergency medical service is a vital public necessity, providing expert and high quality emergency care that dramatically improves the survival and recovery rates of people who experience sudden illness or injury; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Marcos and Hays County had the foresight thirty years ago to form a non-profit corporation to provide emergency medical services, incorporating the San Marcos-Hays County Emergency Medical Services on July 19, 1983; and

WHEREAS, San Marcos Hays County EMS has saved countless lives in its dedicated service to the people of San Marcos and Hays County over these thirty years, aiding the residents of San Marcos, Kyle, Niederwald, Dripping Springs, Driftwood, Henly and Uhland, as well as unincorporated areas of south Hays County and an unincorporated portion of Guadalupe County; and

WHEREAS, the department has grown from seven employees operating one full-time advanced lift support ambulance to 92 employees operating eight full-time advanced life support ambulances, responding to nearly 11,000 calls per year; and

WHEREAS, the San Marcos Hays County EMS stand ready to provide life-saving care to those in need 24 hours a day, seven days a week;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Hays County Commissioners' Court does hereby proclaim July 19, 2013:
