WHEREAS, emergency medical service is a vital public necessity, providing expert and high quality emergency care that dramatically improves the survival and recovery rates of people who experience sudden illness or injury; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Marcos and Hays County had the foresight thirty years ago to form a nonprofit corporation to provide emergency medical services, incorporating the San Marcos-Hays County Emergency Medical Services on July 19, 1983; and
