Women of Distinction Award!




Congratulations, Commissioner Dr. Michelle Cohen!

- Hillside Terrace (from I-35 northbound frontage road to FM 2001)




July 4 - Independence Day

Requests for Vital Records

On the Hays County Clerk's Permitium website, you can request birth, death, and certified marriage certificate copies using our online ordering system. Online requests will be processed during normal business hours: Monday-Friday, 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m.

The Texas Department of State Health Services Office requires that all applicants upload a form of identification when submitting their application.

or all cities in Hays County. This does not include pirths and deaths that occurred within the City of San Marcos, Foxas, which serves as its own local registrar; located at 630 E. Hopkins, San Marcos TX, 78666. If your birth occurred outside of Hays County, but within the State of Texas, you will be issued an Abstract Record (short form), which is still a certified tegal document. The information contained in this request should be considered private. Please complete all information in full and then finalize the order process through payment of the 'order fee'.
